A sharing station is a place where students can place an un-opened food and drinks they chose not to eat or drink. Students donate unwanted food to their hungry classmates at no cost and this helps with reducing food waste. The unwanted food must be placed on the sharing station immediately after leaving the serving line. The sharing station remains open to all students to take from if they see something they would like to eat. At the end of the day the food can be donated to a food bank or charity. Although students are encouraged to chose only what they will eat and eat what they chose, the Sharing Table offers an opportunity for sharing items that would otherwise be thrown away.

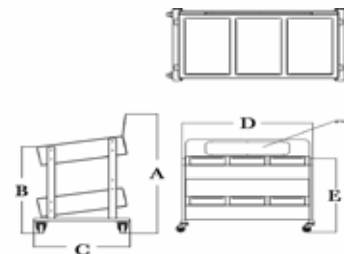
