A Sharing Station is a place where students can place un-opened food and drinks they choose not to eat or drink. Students donate unwanted food at no cost and this helps with reducing food waste. The unwanted food must be placed on the Sharing Station immediately after leaving the serving line. The sharing station remains open to all students to take from if they see something they would like to eat. At the end of the day the food can be donated to a food bank or charity. Although students are encouraged to choose only what they will eat and eat what they choose, the Sharing Station offers an opportunity for sharing items that would otherwise be thrown away.

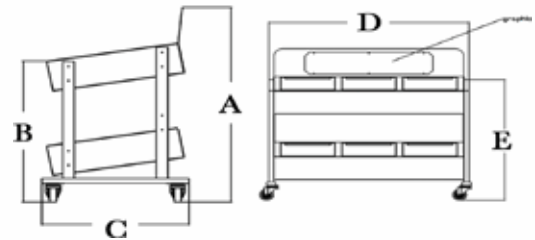
G.A. Systems Sharing Station is constructed from high quality electro-galvanized steel and is powder coated with a variety of color options.
